



The Federal Republic of Germany was created in September, 1949, from the American, British, and French occupation zones. The Russian or eastern zone of occupation was constituted government in October, 1949. Berlin, which was not included in any of the four occupation zones, remains an area under the occupation of the four powers. The rivers are provisionally under the administration of Poland and the Soviet Union. The incorporation of Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania into the Soviet Union in August, 1940, has not been recognized by the United States.
